



**Under Section 22 of the Health Protection and Promotion Act:**

*The order requires all persons who own or operate a Commercial Establishment in the jurisdiction of the Wellington-Dufferin-Guelph Health Unit to:*

Prohibit Persons from entering the premises of the Commercial Establishment or remaining in the premises if the said Person is not wearing a Face Covering. **The Face Covering must be worn inside the Establishment at all times**, unless it is reasonably required to temporarily remove the Face Covering for services provided by the Establishment.

A Person shall be exempt from wearing a Face Covering on the premises if:

The Person is a child under the age of two years;

Wearing a Face Covering would inhibit the Person's ability to breathe in any way; or

For any other medical reason the Person cannot safely wear a Face Covering.
